

Ice Scraper Mitt

based on berroco's ember pattern

SIZE

Approximately 6 1/2" across widest section x 10" long

MATERIALS

I Set (4) double pointed knitting needles (dpn), size 10 1/2 (7.00 mm) OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE

I St marker

I Ice Scraper

GAUGE

14 sts = 4"; 20 rows = 4" in St st with I strand each A and B held tog
TO SAVE TIME, TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGE

NOTE

Entire piece is worked in the round in St st with I strand each of A and B held tog.

ICE SCRAPER COVER

With dpn's, using I strand each of A and B held tog, cast on 32 sts. Divide sts onto 3 needles and join, being careful not to twist sts. Mark for beg of rnd and carry marker up. Work in k2, p2 ribbing for 3 1/4". K the next rnd, inc 16 sts around – 48 sts. Work even in St st (k EVERY rnd) until piece measures 8 1/2" (or desired length) from beg.

Shape Top: Dec Rnd 1: * K1, k2 tog, rep from * around – 32 sts. Knit 1 rnd.

Dec Rnd 2: K1, * k1, k2 tog, rep from * 9 times more, end k1 – 22 sts. Purl 3 rnds. Bind off purlwise. Slip cover over ice scraper.
