

super small sock

co 16 sts leaving a long tail

divide onto two circular needles and join for knitting in the round.

round 1-3: *k1 p1 repeat from * until the end of the round

round 4-15: knit

next you need to rearrange the stitches so the cast on tail is centered on one needle. to do this knit the next 4 stitches then transfer the 4 sts you just knit and the 4 sts just prior to one needle and move the other 8 to the “resting” needle.

heel flap: knit 8 rows st st ending with a RS row

heel turn:

row 1: p4, p2tog, p1, turn

row 2: sl1, ssk, k1, turn

row 3: sl1, p2, p2tog, turn

row 4: sl1, k2, ssk



pick up gusset sts:

pick up 5 stitches along the heel flap then knit 4 from the “resting needle” using the “formerly resting needle” knit 4, pick up 5 sts along the heel flap and knit 2 sts from the other needle. (11 sts on each needle)

gusset rounds

round 1: k5, k2tog, k4.....second needle. k4, ssk, k5

round 2: knit

round 3: k4, k2to, k4.....second needle k4, ssk, k4

round 4: knit

round 5: k3, k2tog, k4.....second needle k4, ssk, k3 (16 sts total, 8 on each needle)

foot: knit 10 rounds

toe: k2, k2tog, ssk , k2 on each needle

knit 1 round

k1, k2to, ssk, k1 on each needle 8 sts remain total

knit 2 and rearrange the sts so you can kitchner the toe....just poke the tail inside the sock

hanger loop: take a length of yarn and using a crochet hook or a needle feed one end through the stitch below the cast on tail. braid and then knot the end. using a tapestry needle to tack the end to the inside of the sock. done and done.
